The members while discussing about the syllabi made the following suggestions

1. Course code TFL 511020 titled 'Introduction to Semiotics' misses Saussure's book on linguistics. It was suggested that the title could be included in the reading list.
2. Further, it was suggested to restructure the units of the paper TFL 511030 titled 'Introduction to Language and Society'.
3. TFL 411050 'Field Methodology' should be renamed as Research Methodology I and subsequently the TFL 421050 Research Methodology should be renamed as Research Methodology II.
4. It was also pointed out that the course lack the detailed break up of marks. Therefore, it was discussed and decided to include a parallel and separate sections consisting of the detailed break up of marks in the 2nd page.
5. Dr. Dev Vrat Singh re-designed the Folklore and Media paper (TFL 521010). It was accepted by the members present. (Attachment annexure # 01)
6. The notion of tradition should be discussed in great details and should be incorporated in the syllabus.
7. Members suggested that in the paper Oral Literature (TFL 411020) the unit 4 could be merged with the unit 1 of the paper. In place of unit 4 a section concerning the tribal literature and with specific reference to the literature of Jharkhand should be introduced.

Resolutions:

There was a discussion concerning the less number of students getting enrolled for the programme in M.A in Folkloristics. Based on the discussion and deliberation among the members following measures were suggested to increase the number of students in the centre getting enrolled for the course in M.A in Folkloristics.

1. Since the seats are left vacant due to insufficient number of students getting enrolled for the programme, it was suggested to develop a mechanism apart from CUCET at regional level to facilitate the local students from Jharkhand to get admissions. This was suggested based on the fact that numerous students from Jharkhand come from a background where technology has yet not penetrated into their day to day lives. This may be one of the reasons as to less number of applicants. So (a) if there is a provision for applying for admission in off-line, (b) a parallel examination at a convenient time keeping in view the factors related to the students from the Jharkhand and adjoining states as well as a (c) Special admission Drive to fill up the seats remaining vacant after the first round of counseling for all the categories of students.
2. Fee structure may be reviewed keeping in view the poor economic condition of people of the region which is predominantly tribal dominated region
3. In connection with the age bar for admission it may be removed.
4. The Centre may initiate short term courses related with skill development.
