BoS Member after detail discussion on the issues, suggested following: A. CTCL is already having one faculty member from Law background. In addition to it, it is suggested that two posts from the Law background be allocated in the existing sanctioned posts. Consideration of their specialization in Tribal Rights must be adhered. B. Further it is suggested to the University that it must sanction two posts in addition to existing strength of seven. Preferred area of specialization being Law/ Tribal
