Weightage 60% to written exam and 40% to practical (audition).	
		Note: Selection will be done on the basis of audition along with the entrance examination. Candidates who fail to attend practical exam/ audition cannot be selected irrespective of the marks secured in the written exam.

MPA in Theatre Arts	Bachelor's degree in any discipline with a minimum 45% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate for General Category and 40% or equivalent grade in aggregate for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ PWD. Experience in theatre or any performing art will be an added advantage. Weightage 60% to written exam and 40% to practical /audition.	
		Note: For the practical /audition candidates are expected to come prepared to perform a dramatic passage from a play of their choice. Candidates who fail to attend practical/ audition cannot be selected irrespective of the marks secured in the written exam.	
3.	M. A. in English	Bachelor's degree in English Literature with a minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate for General Category and 45% or equivalent grade in aggregate for SC/ST/OBC (noncreamy layer)/ PWD.

A. in Hindi	Bachelor's degree in any discipline with minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate for General Category and 45% or equivalent grade in aggregate for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/PWD or equivalent grade. The candidates must have secured at least 50% in Bachelor's as well as in Hindi subject.
