^{*} Wherever relevant to any specific discipline, the API score for paper in refereed journal would be augmented as follows: (i) indexed journals-by 5 points; (ii) papers with impact factor between 1 and 2 by 10 points; (ii) papers with impact factor between 2 and 5 by points; (iv) papers with impact factor between 5 and 10 by 25 points.

Note.

- 1. The API for joint publications will have to be calculated in the following manner: of the total score for the relevant category of publication by the concerned teacher, the first/Principal author and the corresponding author/supervisor/mentor of the teacher would share equally 60% of the total points and the remaining 40% would be shared equally by all other authors.
- 2. The parameters listed in table of category-III (research and Academic contributions) shall have following capping relation to the total API score claimed by the candidates:-

•	III (B): Research publications (Books, etc)	25%
•	III (C): Research Projects	20%
•	III (D): Research Guidance	10%
