Welcome & Introduction

The Vice Chancellor introduced and welcomed the Building Committee Members present and thanked them for attending the first Building Committee Meeting.

Building Committee Role

The Vice Chancellor explained the role of the Building Committee and its importance to the members.

BC:001: 2009/1: Temporary Infrastructure at Brambe

He highlighted the urgent need for immediate expansion of classrooms, research laboratories and other accommodation during this financial year ending 31st March 2009 to cater to the growing requirements now and from the next academic session.

To meet this need, he explained the process of advertising for profiles of parties interested in construction of low cost, pre-fabricated structures, and then asking for quotations. Their Comparative Statement was presented to the members present.

BC:001: 2009/2: Award of Work

The Committee approved the suggestion that the University should first make an architectural plan and detailed estimates and get them vetted by another organisation. Thereafter, "Notice Inviting Tender" should be floated with complete specifications asking for per square foot cost inclusive of all taxes, transportation, etc. sp that payment can be made by simply measuring the area. Further, it was suggested that a day-to-day implementation programme be made to achieve the time target.

BC:001: 2009/3: Permanent Campus

The Vice Chancellor then showed a map of Sukurhuttu where the Government of Jharkhand had identified a site for the permanent campus of CUJ. Although the area was fragmented with private ownerships, the members felt that CUJ should take it up considering its locational advantages. They left campus development work can immediately start while the process of land transfers/acquisitions goes on.
