Keeping a view to complete occupation of the completed buildings, a survey has been made by PMC - WAPCOS Ltd. for requirements of lab equipment, furniture and fixtures for classrooms, laboratories, office spaces for students research scholars, etc. along with security and sports equipment, computer hardware & software, etc. The PMC has submitted its tentative estimate, which is enclosed as **Annexure** - **III**. As per the estimate submitted by the PMC, an amount of Rs. 97.32 Crores is required for complete occupation of the completed buildings at permanent campus of the University.
