



Walk-in-Admission Entrance Test – 2019

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

Science Disciplines :

Minimum 55% marks in qualifying degree for general category and 50% marks for SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer) / PWD candidates or equivalent grade.

Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, Technology and Law :

Minimum 50 % marks in qualifying degree for general category and 45% marks for SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/PWD candidates or equivalent grade.

Performing Arts / Courses offered by Dept. of Tribal Studies :

Minimum 45% marks in qualifying degree for general category and 40% marks for SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/PWD candidates or equivalent grade.

| 01 | B.Ed. : Bachelor of Education | Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Sciences (Zoology/Botany/Life Science) / Humanities (languages) are eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Education programme. |
| 02 | M.A. (Tribal Law and Governance) | Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks. Relaxation as per Govt of India norms. |
| 03 | M.A. (Hindi) | Bachelor's degree in Hindi (Hons.) or should have studied Hindi as a subject in Bachelor's Degree in Arts/Humanities/Commerce. The candidate must have secured at least 50% in Bachelor's as well as in Hindi subject. |
| 04 | M.A. (Mass Communication) | Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with minimum 50% marks for General category and 45% marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates |
| 05 | M.A. (English) | B.A. English (Hons.) with 50 % marks for general category and 45% marks for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates or equivalent grade. |
| 06 | M.A. (Folklore) | Any graduate with 45% marks. (40% for SC, ST, OBC, PWD applicants) |

| 07 | M.A. (Political Science) with specialization in International Relations | Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 50% marks. Relaxation as per Govt. of India norms |
| 08 | Masters in Performing Arts (Vocal Music/Theatre Arts) | Vocal Music : BPA / B.Mus. / BA (Music) / B.A. (any discipline with Diploma / Prabhakar / Sangeet Visharad or equivalent) Theatre Arts : Bachelor degree in any discipline. (Separate question papers shall be set) Note: Selection will be done on the basis of audition along with entrance examination |
| 09 | M.A. (Anthropology & Tribal Studies) | Any graduate with Anthropology or Tribal Studies having 45% marks (40% for SC, ST, OBC, PWD). |
| 10 | M.A. (Ancient Indian History & Archaeology) | Graduation in Indian History, Culture Studies or Archaeology with 50% marks (45% for SC, ST, OBC and PWD) |
| 11 | LL.M. (Tribal and Customary Law / Human Rights) | Bachelor's degree in Law with at least 50% marks (or equivalent grade). Relaxation as per GoI norms |
| 12 | M.Sc. (Mathematics) | Bachelor's degree with Mathematics / Statistics but should have studied mathematics in all the three years. |
| 13 | M.Sc. (Chemistry) | Bachelors degree with Chemistry as a Major / Honours subjects. The student must have studied Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics at 10 +2 level. |
| 14 | M.Sc. (Physics) | Bachelors degree with Physics as a Major / Honours subject. The student must have studied Physics and Mathematics at 10+2 level. |
| 15 | M.Sc. (Life Sciences) | B.Sc. (Hons/Major) in Bio-Sciences / Botany / Zoology / Biology / Biotechnology / Bio-chemistry / Life Science / Microbiology / Genetics / Agriculture Science / Animal Sciences |
| 16 | M.Sc. (Environmental Science) | B.Sc. (Hons/Major) / B.Tech. / B.E. in any discipline of Environmental Sciences and its allied subjects such as Agricultural / Forestry / Earth Sciences or Remote Sensing. |
| 17 | M.Sc. (Geoinformatics) | Bachelors (Hons. /Major) in Environmental Science / Forestry / Geography / Chemistry / Physics / Geology / Geophysics / Mathematics / Oceanography / Agriculture / Atmospheric Science / Climatology / Information Science / Computer Science / Disaster Management / Electronics / Town Planning / Botany / Zoology or any allied discipline. |

| 24 | PG Diploma (Rural & Tribal Development) | Graduate in any discipline. |
| 25 | PG Diploma (Industrial & Occupational Health Safety) | B.Sc. / B.Tech. in relevant subject (Environmental Science / Environmental Management / Earth & Atmospheric Science / Meteorology / Plant Science / Forestry / Animal Science or any allied subject or any graduate with minimum of 3 years of experience in industry. |
