# Discussions on Item 8, New Courses:

The Vice Chancellor explained, point-wise, the actions taken on matters arising out of the previous meeting's minutes. He also informed the AC members about the two Central committees that were to submit a report by 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2010 and that the report was

The Vice Chancellor informed that preliminary discussions were started with the Asian Institute of Technology, Bangkok for the proposal on Nanotechnology and that email correspondence was being made with the University of Birmingham U.K. for Water Engineering & Management.

It was suggested that a Vision Plan be made for the next five to 20 years so as to include as many Schools & Centres and Courses for approval by the UGC. Subjects related to Jharkhand, like courses on coal industry, may be included in the Vision Plan. It was further suggested that a National Conference may organised to discuss a Vision Plan for CUJ.

The members discussed introduction of inter-disciplinary courses keeping in mind not to replicate as far as possible, courses offered by Ranchi University.

Resolved to hold a National Conference/ Workshop on Vision Plan 2015 for CUJ and tring out the document

Resolved further that a Vision Plan could be prepared for the next 5 and 20 years keeping in view the Interdisciplinary courses and courses not being offered in the state Universities.

# AC:2010/2/003 Status Report Presentation, review on

The Central University of Jharkhand was officially established on the 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2009, with the joining of the first Vice-Chancellor. A Status Report (Annexure I) on the progress made, the present status and the future courses of action was presented by the Vice-Chancellor to the Academic Council for consideration and advice.

At this stage, the Academic Council congratulated and recorded its words of appreciation for the Vice-Chancellor on the tremendous progress made during the past one year and commended him and his team.

It was noted that a proposal for new courses had been sent to UGC in October 2009 for consideration but yet to receive a response from UGC.

The Academic Council expressed its concern over this and was of the view that identification of courses of study is the prerogative of the Academic Council and not of another Central Committee.

## AC:2010/2/004 Draft Regulations on Grading System

It was noted that Academic Council in its first meeting considered the Ordinance for adoption of the Choice Based Credit System and approved the same as per recommendation of UGC.

It was also agreed that out of two grading systems cited by UGC, the grading system of JNU be adopted.

The draft Regulations. RA-1, was placed for consideration. (Annexure II)

#### After thorough discussion:

Resolved that the proposed grading system will be reviewed so as to include the provision of weightage in grading as per the discipline offered.

Resolved further that the approach of University of Hyderabad in this context could be looked into.

### AC: 2010/2/005 Draft Regulations on Recruitment Rules

The recruitment guidelines for Statutory posts and faculty positions are given in the Statutes and Ordinances. For other posts, non teaching in nature, detailed recruitment rules have been framed, based on UGC and Government of India recruitment rules. Criteria for qualification for merit based promotion in some posts ( Deputy Registrar, Assistant Registrar ) was in consultation with another Central University.

The draft Recruitment Rules were placed for consideration. ( Annexure III ). The members acknowledged that these matters were largely for the Executive Council to consider.

Resolved that feedback if any would be conveyed to the Vice-Chancellor within the next three weeks by the Hon'ble members.

Resolved further to recommend that the due weightage to professional experience vis-à-vis degree qualification, especially in areas in Mass Communication and Fine and Performing Arts be provided.

AC: 2010/2/006 Term of Vice-Chancellor, MHRD communication on

A communication was recently received from the Ministry of Human Resources Development (Annexure IV) wherein it was advised that should a University deem it fit to provide for a second term for a Vice-Chancellor, the matter may be placed before the appropriate Statutory bodies for consideration. The term of the '/ice-Chancellor of the Central university of Jharkhand is presently limited to one term.

The matter was placed before the Council for consideration and advice.

### After thorough discussion:

Resolved that Statutes 2(4) could be amended accordingly to include a provision for a second term of the Vice-Chancellor provided that Search Committee, as is normally constituted, reviews and recommends such an extension to an incumbent.

AC: 2010/2/007 Appointments and Recruitments

The Vice Chancellor informed the members that Her Excellency the President of India, had been pleased to appoint **Dr. Shyam Narayan**, Deputy Registrar, Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi, as the first Registrar and **Shri Pramod Kumar Singh**, Chief Accounts Officer, Patna Regional Development Authority, Patna, as the first Finance Officer of the Central University of Jharkhand.

Mr. N.P. Garg, former University Engineer, North Eastern Hill University, Shillong, had been appointed as the Officer on Special Duty-Campus Development.
