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The Vice Chancellor, Prof. D. T. Khathing, warmly welcomed the members present in the 9th meeting of the Academic Council. He expressed his deep gratitude for their coming from different parts of the country personally to advise the University in its



endeavour to create a centre of Excellence. He gave a brief introduction on the Agenda items, highlighting the Annual Report as the main Agenda.

The Vice Chancellor also highlighted some of the recent academic achievements. These included the month long attachment with the Centre of Life Sciences of a Scientist, Dr. Hamdino M.I. Ahmad, from Egypt, under the DST sponsored CV Raman International Fellowship for African Researchers; the sanction of two UGC major Research Projects in English have been received - one to Professor B.P. Sinha, titled "Multicultrual Response to Lost Tradition with Special Reference to Tribal Literature in Jharkhand" and another to Dr. Sandeep Kumar Yadav titled "Abrogating 'Authenticity' with a Difference: Indian Poetry in English since 1980-2000"; CUJ has been included as Associate Partner of "Erasmus Mundus Action 2" where 8 (eight) European Union Universities and 10 (ten) Universities from India are establishing a consortium (Ghent University of Belgium is coordinating); with the exit option in CUJ after the 3rd year, two of our students have been admitted into prestigious institutions for their post graduate studies - Mr. Raman Gupta of the Centre of Applied Mathematics has successfully been admitted to the Integrated Ph.D. Programme of TIFR Center for Applied Mathematics, Bangalore and Mr. Jami Amaresh of the Centre of Business Administration has been admitted to Dublin City University, Ireland for a PGDM Programme; Dr. Rabindra Nath Sharma of Centre of Indigenous Culture has been invited as an Visiting Faculty for two months by the Department of Estonia and Comparative Folklore University of Tartu, Estonia.

The University has also progressed successfully in its endeavour to network and establish collaborative programmes with foreign Universities. In today's agenda, at least four MoUs are being placed for consideration. All students of Mass Communication and Business Administration have found good placement for Internship in different parts of the country and with well known organizations & companies.

The Academic Council recorded its words of appreciation for the excellent academic and administrative work done by the University during last three years.

- Chairperson
- (ii) All Deans of Schools
- Members
- (iii) Controller of exams
- Member
- (iv) Finance officer
- Member

(iv) Registrar

- Member Secretary

Function

- The functions of this Committee will be as follows:
 - a. To consider deputation of teachers for international Conferences;
 - b. To consider such matters as may be necessary arising from the conduct of examinations, standard of results, etc;
 - c. To consider general administrative matters relating to functioning of Schools and Departments; and
 - d. To consider such other matters as may be assigned to it by the Executive Council or may be referred to by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 3. The meetings of the Deans' Committee shall be convened by the Chairperson.

Quorum

- 4. The quorum of the Committee shall be 1/3rd of the total number.
- 5. The rules of conduct of meetings shall be as may be prescribed by Regulations

Note: In case of any doubt or contradiction of these rules, Instructions of Govt. of India. Ministry of Human Resource Development and the University Grants Commission, shall prevail

An Ordinance governing the Functioning of Employees and Student's Grievances Redressal Committee at Central University of Jharkhand is prepared on the line of Model Ordinances received from UGC. This is as follows:

CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF JHARKHAND ORDINANCE ON

EMPLOYEES AND STUDENTS GRIEVENCES REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

[Under Section 28(n) of the Central University Act, 2009]

There shall be constituted a Mechanism for the redressal of the grievances of Employees and Students of the University.

Meaning

Unless otherwise mentioned:

Student means all students who are registered for a Programme of study in any School/Centre/Department College or Campus maintained by the University.

Employee means any person appointed by the University and includes teachers and other staff of the University.

General Principles The Grievances Committee shall observe the following general principles:

- 1. The Campus Community should be made fully aware of the grievance redressal Mechanism;
- 2. Every grievance from the student/ staff should be registered and acknowledged;
- 3. If a final decision is not possible within a fortnight, an acknowledgement should be sent to the applicant along with an indication as to when he/she can expect a final reply;
- 4. As a matter of general rule no grievances should remain pending beyond the limit of three months;
- 5. The officer nominated by the Vice-Chancellor and the person responsible for addressing grievances should make himself/herself freely available to hear the grievances personally, at least once a week at fixed timings; and
- 6. He/she will take decisions on grievances which are pending for more than three months. Aggrieved parties who are not satisfied with redressal in subordinate/attached formation can approach the Vice-Chancellor for a decision.

I. STUDENTS GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL COMMITTEE

Chairman – The Pro Vice-Chancellor or such other person to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

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Members:

3 Representative of Students' Council.

3 Nominees of the Vice-Chancellor.

Dean of Students' welfare, Member-Secretary.

Dean of the School concerned (special invitee)

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

(i)to entertain written and signed complaints and petitions of student in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as a group;

(ii) to enquire into the grievances, and make recommendations and report to the concerned authorities – Academic Council and Executive Council for redressal or suitable action; and

(iii)to recommend appropriate action against complainant, if allegations

made in the documents are found to be baseless.

II. TEACHERS' GRIEVANCES COMMITTEE

There shall be constituted a Committee by the Executive Council consisting of the following:

Vice-Chancellor or his/ her representative Chairman.

Five representatives from the teaching community representing gender, minority, SC,ST & OBC

Vice-Chancellor's nominee shall be the Secretary to the Committee.

POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

(i) to entertain written and signed complaints and petitions of teachers in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as group;

(ii) to enquire into the grievances, and make recommendations and report to the concerned authorities – Academic Council and Executive Council for redressal or suitable action; and

(iii)to recommend appropriate action against complainant, if allegations

made in the documents are found to be baseless.

III.NON-TEACHING STAFF GRIEVANCES COMMITTEE

The Chairman- to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.

Five representatives from the non-teaching community representing gender, minority, SC,ST & OBC

The Registrar or his/her nominee shall be the Member-Secretary of the Committee.

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POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

(i) to accept and consider written and signed complaints and petitions of staff (Non-teaching) in respect of matters directly affecting them individually or as group;

(ii) to enquire into the grievances, and make recommendations and report to the concerned authorities – Academic Council and Executive Council for redressal or switch!

redressal or suitable action; and

(iii) to recommend appropriate action against complainants, if allegations made in the documents are found to be baseless.

[Under Section 28(1)(0) of the Central University Act 2009]

Ragging is prohibited and punishable under the UGC Regulations on "Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions (2009)" notified vide No. F.1-6/2009(CPP-II) dated 21.10.2009 and as amended by the UGC from time to time.

The functioning and terms & conditions shall be specified under the Regulations of the University.

2. A draft Regulation (Annexure XVI) under the above Ordinance is submitted for consideration and approval.

CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF JHARKHAND ORDINANCE ON

PROCEDURE FOR CO-OPERATION AND COLLABORATION WITH OTHER UNIVERSITIES, INSTITUTIONS AND OTHER AGENCIES INCLUDING LEARNED BODIES OR ASSOCIATIONS

[Under Section 28(1)(o) of the Central University Act 2009]

- 1. In consonance with the provision under section 5, 6(x) (xiv) of the Central Universities Act 2009, the University envisages to network and collaborate with other institutions of repute from India and abroad.
- 2. The University may network and collaborate with Institutions of higher Education, research institutions, industry, and/or NGOs of National and International repute.
- 3. The objective of such networking and collaboration shall be to further teaching, research, extension, consultancy aimed at providing opportunities of enhanced learning, hands on experience, cross-cultural dialogue and exchange of ideas for its faculty, research scholars and students.
- 4. With the above in view, the University may enter into Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with other institutions of national and international repute.
- 5. Any proposal received and/or initiated by the University to enter into an MOU with other institutions shall be examined by a Committee comprising the following:
 - i. The Vice Chancellor or his/her nominee, who shall be the chairperson
 - Two faculty members not below the rank of Professor, to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor
 - iii. The Registrar
 - iv. The Deans of the Schools concerned
 - v. The Head of Centre/Programme concerned

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- vi. Coordinator, External Relations who shall be the Member Secretary
- 6. The Committee, referred as above, shall examine the proposal taking into consideration all aspects involving rights and obligations of the University and will make a recommendation as to whether it is in the interest of the University to enter into the MOU.
- 7. Recommendations of the Committee together with the draft of the MOU shall be placed for the consideration and approval of the Academic Council and Executive Council of the University.
- 8. All MOUs are to be for a specified time period and shall be reviewed periodically by the Committee for extension/continuation.
- In such situation/cases not covered in these rules, Provisions of GFR, instructions
 of Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development and the
 University Grants Commission, shall be followed.

An Ordinance Governing the functioning of Students Council at Central University of Jharkhand is prepared on the line of Model Ordinances received from UGC. This is as follows:

CENTRAL UNIVERSITY OF JHARKHAND ORDINANCE ON THE STUDENT'S COUNCIL

[Under Section 28(1)(0) of the Central University Act 2009]

1. Constitution:

The University may constitute a Council of Students for every academic year, consisting

- 1.1 The Dean Students' Welfare who shall be the ex-officio Chairman of the Students' Council.
- 1.2 Twenty students to be nominated by the Academic Council on the basis of merit in studies, sports and extra-curricular activities
 - 1.2.1 The Committee Consisting of all Deans/Heads or Co-ordinators of various centres will prepare a list of 20 students as potential members of the Council comprising of 12 students from 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th 5th& 6th Semester and students from 7th, 8th, 9th& 10th Semester on the basis of merit in studies, sports and extra-curricular activities. The Committee may consider giving weight age of the above criteria in such a manner as it deems necessary.
 - 1.2.2 Out of which, at least one girl student and one student each from SC, ST, OBC & physically challenged category shall be there. In case no student is found suitable in a particular category, the seat will go to unreserved category.
 - 1.2.3 The Controller of Examination shall make available the marks obtained by the three highest scorers centre-wise in the last two semester exams to the above committee. Similarly other respective in-charges of Sports and extracurricular activities shall also make available a list of three best students centre-wise in the field of sports and extra-curricular activities to the above committee.
 - 1.2.4 The committee constituted for the above shall submit its recommendations before the Academic Council which shall nominate the members of the students' council
- 1.3 Twenty students to be elected by the students as their representatives.
 - 1.3.1 For election of Student Representative up to 10th Semester, a Committe consisting of Dean/Heads/Co-ordinators and other three teachers of the faculty shall be constituted.
 - 1.3.2 The Committee shall notify to invite nominations from amongst the top TWENTY students from each semester.
 - 1.3.3 Criteria for nominaton shall be Merit Index for last examination passed, and merit of the last examination passed for 2nd Semster onwards.



- 1.3.4 Out of these Top TWENTY students of each semseter, TWO student be nominated unanimously by all these students for the Students' Council.
- 1.3.5 In case of any divided opinion, the above Committee reserves the power to nominate ONE OR TWO students as the case may be, from amongst all top TWENTY students of each semester a member of the Students' Council.
- 1.3.6 The student already nominated as member of the Students' Council under clause 1.2 above shall not be eligible to be selected under this clause i.e. 1.3
- 1.3.7 After selection of Student Representative, all top TWENTY students of each semester and the committee shall sign the pre designed format, which shall be sent to the Dean Students' Welfare for further process of constitution of the University Students' Council.
- 1.4 Notwithstanding any thing contained in the clauses 1.2 and 1.3 above, the students shall be nominated in the Students' Council, provided the student:
 - 1.4.1 Should be on roll of the University on the date of nomination.
 - 1.4.2 Should have paid the fees due from him/her
 - 1.4.3 Has not completed the age of 25 years on 1st July immediately preceding the nomination
 - 1.4.4 Has not failed in any examination of the Central University of Jharkhand
 - 1.4.5 No disciplinary action leading to expulsion/rustucation in any educational institution had been taken against him/her
 - 1.4.6 Has never been convicted in any criminal offence.
 - 1.4.7 Has never been punished for any act of violence, assuaults and use of unfair means in the examination.
 - 1.4.8 Has never been nominated to the Students' Council. A student once nominated to the students' Council shall not be eligible for re-nomination in any subsequent year.

Provided that any student of the University shall have the right to bring up any matter concerning the University before the Students' Council, if so permitted by the Chairman, and he shall have the right to particiapte in the discussions at any meeting when the matter is taken up for consideration.

- 2. Function: The functions of the Students' Council shall frame its policies and programmes and shall perform such other activities as would further the objectives of the Council and to make suggestions to the Vice Chancellor of the University in regard to-
 - 2.1. Academic: The Council shall suggest from time to time ideas to improve the academic atmosphere of the University. For this purpose, it will organize debates, quiz, essay competitions, poem writing, exptempore presentation, and other extracurricular activities at the Faculty and University level. Any grievance from student's side regarding academic matters may also be considered by the Council for its amicable solution.
 - 2.2. Sports: The Council may suggest the facilities to be provided to the students to improve sports and games activities. The Council shall motivate the students to

- participate in different sports activities. Any grievance from students pertaining to sports and games may also be looked into by the Council for its timely redressal.
- 2.3. Cultural Activities: The Council shall help in organizing cultural activities at the Faculty as well as University level. The Council shall motivate the students to participate in different cultural activities.
- 2.4. Hostel Development: With a view to providing family atmosphere, the Coucil shall prepare proposals for improvement of the basic facilities and plans for improvement in living conditions in the hostels.
- 2.5. Students Welfare: The Council shall suggest ways and means for providing financial assistance, special library facilities and hostel accommodation to the needy students.
 - 2.6. Health & Hygiene: The Council shall suggest ways to improve the medical facilities and address to the grievances for betterment of the health and hygiene conditions of the students.
 - 2.7. Law and Discipline : The Council shall take steps to maintain discipline among the students. It shall consider and attempt to resolve the grievances of the students.
 - 2.8. Social Activities: The Council may suggest from time to time ways and means to promote various social activities by the students in and around the campus such as literacy, cleanliness, health & hygiene.

The above suggestions shall be made on the basis of consensus of opinion.

- 3. Meetings
- The Students' Council should ordinarily meet at least twice in every academic year and the first meeting of the council be held in the beginning of the academic session.
- 4. Procedures
- The Council may determine its own procedure for working.
- 5. Quorum
- The Quorum of the Council shall be one third of the total members.
- 6. Term
- The term of the office of the members other than ex-officio Chairman shall be for a period of one year from the date of constitution.

 - (i) The Dean of Students' Welfare, who shall be the Chairperson;
 - (ii) Two prominent sportspersons to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor;
 - (iii) One Outstanding Sportsman/Sportswoman from among the students on rolls, nominated by the Chairman for a period of one year; and
 - (iv) The Director of Physical Education, who shall be the Ex-Officio Member-Secretary of the Games and Sports Committee.

Function

- 2. The Committee shall:
 - (i) take measures to attract the sports talent available in the University;
 - (ii) make arrangements and supervise the games and sports of the University and frame Regulations in this regard;
 - (iii) propose the budgetary requirements for games and sports;
 - (iv) maintain the play-grounds, gymnasia, swimming pools and other sports facilities of the University;
 - (v) hold/organise contests, competitions, tournaments, athletic meets etc.;
 - (vi) recommend to the Vice-Chancellor the names of outstanding players/ sportspersons to be nominated for admission under sports quota, if any;
 - (vii) recommend to the Vice Chancellor names of the Outstanding player/Sportspersons for training/coaching facilities/stipend, if any; and
 - (viii) perform such other functions, as may be assigned to it by the Executive Council/ Academic Council/ Vice Chancellor from time to time.



3. The Director, Physical Education will operate the allotted fund under the supervision of the Dean of Students' Welfare.

Meeting

4. The Committee shall hold its meetings at least once in two months under the supervision of the Dean Students' Welfare.

Quorum

- 5. One-third of the total members shall form the quorum for a meeting of the Committee.
- 6. In such situation/cases not covered in these rules, instructions of Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development and the University Grants Commission, shall be followed.

Function

- 1. There shall be an Alumni Association of the University.
- 2. The objective of the Association shall be to promote the objectives of the University, to maintain contacts and solidarity among the graduates of the University, and to raise funds for the development of the University.
- 3. The membership of the Association shall be open to all degree holders of the University, including the holders of diplomas and certificates.
- 4. The membership fee for the Association, shall be Rs. 500/= per year and Rs. 10,000/= for life or as decided by the Executive Council of the University from time to time.
- 5. There shall also be an Alumni Association Admission fee of Rs 100/- which shall be collected at the time of admission of students in the university.
- 6. The application for membership shall be in a form prescribed by the University.
- 7. The Executive Committee of the Association shall consist of the
 - (a) President;
 - (b) Vice President:
 - (c) General Secretary;
 - (d) Joint Secretary; and
 - (e) 10 other Members.
- 8. The Vice-Chancellor shall be the ex-officio Patron. All other office -bearers and members of the Association shall be elected for a term of three years.



- 9. No member of the Association shall be entitled to vote or stand for election unless he has been a member of the Association for at least one year prior to the date of the election and is a degree holder of the University of at least five years' standing.
- 10. Provided that the condition relating to the completion of one year membership shall not apply in case of the first election.
- 11. The funds of the Association shall be managed by the Finance Officer of the University who will maintain a separate Account for the purpose.
- 12. The elections of the Association and all its meetings shall be conducted in the manner to be prescribed by Regulations.
- 13. In case of any difficulty in operating any clause of the Ordinance the matter shall be referred to the Vice-Chancellor whose decision thereon shall be final.
- 14. In such situation/cases not covered in these rules, instructions of Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development and the University Grants Commission, shall be followed.
