It is notified for information and compliance of all concerned that in pursuance of resolution taken in the 14th Academic Councils meeting held on 13.04.2018 and its subsequent approval by the Executive Council in its 25th meeting held on 27.07.2018, the following amendment be made in the Ordinance namely "Admission of Student to the University and its Recognized Institutes (OA-13):

Existing ORDINANCE ON ADMISSION OF STUDENT TO THE UNIVERSITY AND ITS RECOGNIZED INSTITUTES (OA13)

- 5. Admission to the 5-year integrated programme, if any, shall be made on the basis of All India entrancetest or through any other method as may be provided for in Regulations(s).
- 6. Admission to the 7th semester in a 5year intergraded programme or to Post Graduate and Μ. Phil programmes shall be made by the Admission Committee as constituted by the Centre/ Department/ School. The Committee shall consist of the Head of the Department/Centre, Dean of the School as Chairman and two senior most faculty of the Department / Centre the members.
- 7. Admission to the programme leading to the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy shall be considered by the concerned school Board.
- 10. 15% of the seats in the academic programmes/programmes offered by the University shall be reserved for students belonging to Scheduled Caste, 7.5% for students belonging to Scheduled Tribe.

- 5. Admission to the programmes of studies shall be made on the basis of All India entrance-test or through any other method as may be provided for in the Regulations(s).

1. Reservations

- (a) The reservation of seats for admission shall be provided in the following manner:
 - i. Out of the annual permitted strength in each course of study, 15% seats shall be reserved for students belonging to Scheduled Castes (SCs)
 - ii. Out of the annual permitted strength in each course of study, 7.5% seats shall be reserved for students

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Provided that the University may also make such special provision for the admission of candidates belonging to the physically handicapped and such other disadvantaged groups on the recommendations of the Academic Council from time to time.

- belonging to Scheduled Tribes (STs)
- iii. Out of the annual permitted strength in each course of study, 27% seats shall be reserved for students belonging to Other Backward Classes (OBCs)
- (b) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Clause 10 (a), 5% seats shall be reserved for persons with benchmark disabilities. The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission.
- (c) Notwithstanding anything contained in the clause 10(a), 15% of supernumerary seats of the annual permitted strength in each course of study may be created exclusively for foreign students and under no circumstances a seat remained vacant shall be allocated to anyone else than a foreign student. Provided that 5% seats shall be earmarked for the children of Indian workers in the Gulf out of 15% supernumerary seats for foreign students in university departments.
- (d) 5% of the seats are reserved for Children /Widows of the Officers and men of Armed Forces including paramilitary personnel killed / disabled during the hostilities over and above the sanctioned seat.

Priority of the CW of Armed Forces are:

 i. Widows/Wards of Defence personnel / Para-Military Personnel killed in action.

<u>Required Certificate</u>: Proof in Original.

ii. Wards of serving Defence Personnel and ex-servicemen/ Para-Military Personnel Disabled in

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action

Required Certificate: Original disability certificate clearly indicating the disability is attributable to Military Service

iii. Widows/wards of Defence Personnel/Para-Military Personnel who died in peace time with death attributable to Military Service.

Required Certificate: Original death certificate clearly indicating the cause of death is attributable to Military Services.

iv. Wards of Defence Personnel/Para-Military Personnel disabled in peace time with disability attributable to Military Service.

Required Certificate: Original disability certificate clearly indicating the disability is attributable to Military Service.

v. Wards of serving Defence Personnel and ex-servicemen Para-Military /Police Personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards.

(h) Two (02) seats over and above the sanctioned seats in each course shall be reserved for Kashmiri Migrants candidate as per letter No. DO No.F.1-1/2012(SA-III) 11th July, 2016

> A certificate of competent authority for availing admission against Kashmiri Migrant Quota is to be produced by the candidates at the time of counselling/admission.

> {UGC Secretary (Prof Dr. Jaspal S Sandhu) letter No DO No. F.1-1/2012(SA-III) 11th July, 2016}

(i) One (01) seat shall be reserved for sports quota applicant. All the sports quota candidate may get additional weightage in CUCET marks as 15% for International, 10% for National and 5% for state level games/sports irrespective of number of participation (highest level of games/sports). Such candidates will occupy the category seats, if applicable.

2. Relaxation:

A relaxation of 5% of marks, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/ Differently-abled and other categories of candidates.

3. Issue of Kashmiri Migrants

The concession extended to Kashmiri Migrant vide UGC letter No. 1-13/210(CPP-II) dated 2.03.2018 shall be followed by the University in admission.

New Clause

17. The Remittance and Refund of Fees and other Student – centric issues will be dealt with in accordance with the Notification of December 2016 on the subject issued by the UGC vide its DO letter No. 1-3/2007(CPP-II) dated 6th December, 2016.
