

The Yeungnam University has forwarded the following by inviting interested CUJ students. The last date of submission of the application to South Korea is 30<sup>th</sup> Nov, 2012 for the spring session starting March 2013.

Interested students may submit their application by the 7<sup>th</sup> Nov 2012, in consultation with their respective Co-ordinator/Head. Such application will be screened by the Deans Committee before forwarding to South Korea.

**Outline of Student Exchange Program at Yeungnam University**

1. Academic Affairs

Yeungnam is also providing a variety of courses in English, and here enclosed is the list of courses for the fall semester of 2012. The course list is confirmed one month prior to each semester and I will also keep you posted on the list of courses in the spring semester of 2013 sooner than later.

2. LPP (Language Partner Program) covers the cost of room and board.

In order to attract more exchange students, the Office of International Programs, Yeungnam University (YU) created a program called, "Language Partner Program (LPP)". In this program, the international exchange students at YU study English with YU students during the semester and YU offers the payment for joining the program. More specifically, any invited exchange students who have a good command of English are eligible to apply for the program. They will be selected for the program throughout our internal assessment such as interviews by our office. The chosen exchange student will be a leader of English study groups (he or she will take 2 groups and study English for 4 hours per week for each team). The payment for the leader is 400,000 Korean Won (about US\$350.00) per month. The duration of the program is 3 months (from early March to early June for spring semester/ from early September to early December for fall semester). Totally, they will be awarded 1,200,000 Korean Won (400,000 Korean Won x 3 months). The total amount of 1,200,000 Korean Won covers the cost of room and board (about 600,000 Korean Won for the cost of on-campus housing for 4 months (March to June for spring semester & September to December for fall semester) and another 600,000 Korean Won for the unlimited meal plan at the dorm cafeteria for

the same duration above). Any students from your institution will be mostly welcome to LPP of Yeungnam any time.

3. WTK (Window to Korea) is a chance to explore all about Korea with YU students.

It is such a wonderful opportunity for the invited exchange students to learn about the best of cultural heritages in Korea with more than 5000-year splendid history. Any exchange students and their YU Korean students can apply for this program with their own theme of where to visit and what to explore in Korea. Once they are chosen after the Office of International Programs screens their proposal, their team will be given some amount of financial support (about US\$250) for their trip and study.

4. Buddies are guiding lights for the exchange students.


All of incoming exchange students are supposed to have their own buddies of YU students. Buddies will be friends and guides for exchange students by helping exchange students for the registration of the courses, finding out where to shop, expanding exchange students' network with other YU students, introduce the student club, inviting them to buddies' home and so on.

Spring semester of Korean universities including Yeungnam University is from early March to mid of June, and fall semester is from early September to mid of December. If you want to send your students for spring and fall of 2013, please refer to the followings:

1. Application deadline for spring of 2013 is the end of November and the end of May is for fall of 2013.
2. All of incoming exchange students must obtain the D-2 visa. Once the exchange students have the admission to Yeungnam University, they can apply for the visa with requested documents at the Korean Embassy or Consulate near your place. The list of documents for the visa is varying from each country, but a photo copy of a passport, a standard admission letter (issued by Yeungnam University) and a certificate of the latest scholastic achievement are the common ones to the Embassy or Consulate.
